A Student who has attendance less than 75% but not less than 65% will also be eligible to appear in the University Examination as a non-collegiate student by paying a non-collegiate fee of Rs.50/- to the Calcutta University.

A Student having attendance less than 65% is not eligible to appear in the University Examination.

Students seeking admission to this college must bear in mind that there is no relaxation in the above regulation for reasons whatever as the same is beyond the powers of the college authority.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

a) The Central Library of the College has a rich collection of both text and reference books. The Library also subscribes a number of journals and newspapers. Besides having reading room facility students are allowed to borrow library books for home reading. The college library is fully computerised with free access to students for searching of books and journals. Students can also Browse Internal to consult the books and journals through internet.

b) **DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY :** The B.Ed. Deptt. also possesses a Departmental Library which has a rich collection of both text and reference books.

Students are allowed to borrow books from the Departmental Library also.

SEMINAR : The College has Seminar facility, Seminars on relevant topics are being held where both students and teachers participate.

LABORATORY : The College has well equipped separate Laboratories in Physics, Chemistry, Life Science, Geography, Psychology, Language & Educational Technology. The College also has Audio Visual equipments for language Lab and Educational Technology Lab of the B.Ed. students. Language Lab is specially equipped with modern computer software & e-learning facilities.

COLLEGE DISCIPLINE

All students shall have to conform to the high standard of discipline and conduct. Obedience to the college authority is obligatory to all students. STUDENTS' UNION

There is a Students' Union run by the elected representatives and office bearers under the supervision of one Teacher-in-charge of Students' Union.

COMMON ROOM

There are separate Common Rooms for Ladies and Gents. A Matron has been appointed for the Ladies Common Room.

CANTEEN

The College has a cheap canteen inside its campus where tea, snacks and other food stuff are available. The Canteen is run by the College through contractor.

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EDUCATIONAL EXCURSION

Students are encouraged for organizing excursion to historical places, cultural and industrial centers, museums, sites of scientific interest etc. under the guidance of the teachers.

Financial support is available from the college only for holding such excursion mainly in Life science & Geography.

RAILWAY CONCESSION

Students are entitled to avail Railway concession as per the rules & regulation of the Indian Railways. Necessary supports are available from the college authorities.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

(A) **Deputation Allowance :** Deputed teacher trainees from recognized Govt. aided school are entitled to get deputation allowance from the Govt. for a period not more than ten and a half months on the basis of last pay certificate submitted to the college by them from their respective schools. The payment of the deputation allowance to the concerned trainees is subject to the receipt of the grants from the Govt. The College, therefore, takes no responsibility to pay such allowances to the trainees in time unless the same is received from the Govt.

(B) **Financial support for S.C./S.T. Students :** S.C./S.T. fresher students are entitled to receive a part of the fees payable to the college by them from the Director, S.C./S.T. Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal, as per Government rules on application.

(C) **Minority Student :** Minority Students are entitled to receive a part of the fees payable to the college by them from the West Bengal Minority Development Finance Corporation.

(D) **Financial support to the Poor Students :** Upto the Maximum of 5% Candidates may get half/full free studentship for admission depending upon their family's financial condition.

COLLEGE FEES

Each B.Ed. trainee will have to pay a consolidated sum of *Rs.10,100/- (Rupees Ten Thousand One Hundred) only as Annual package at the time of admission in one single instalment. The package will include all charges as admission fee, tuition fee,

The medium of instruction in the College is English.

Percentage of attendance :

As per regulation of the Calcutta University, a student will have to attend a minimum of 75% of the lectures, delivered in each subject including practical work separately in order to be eligible to appear in the University examination as a regular collegiate student.

HISTORY

Birla College of Science and Birla College of Education were established in 1968 as two separate institutions. In 1969 the two institutions were amalgamated into one college under the name and style of Birla College of Science and Education. It was renamed as Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose College with effect from the 1st July 1987. It is a non-Govt. college under the pay packet scheme of the Govt. of West Bengal and is managed by a Governing Body formed in terms of the Calcutta University Statutes.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO B.ED. COURSE

GENERAL

Admission to B.Ed. Course is open to both male and female fresher students who have either graduated and obtained a Master degree in the same subject in Arts or Science from any University recognized by UGC with at least 50% marks (relaxation of 10% marks for S.C./S.T. Candidates, 45% for Physically Candidates). According to the Calcutta University rules 95% of the seats are reserved for the Calcutta university candidates (who have obtained last relevant degree from C.U.), while the rest 5% seats are reserved for candidates from other Universities recognized by the U.G.C.. Students from other Universities need to register their names under C.U. after admission in the B.Ed. Course. Admission will be made on the basis of qualification merit and Govt. / C.U. rules and orders.

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Seats for SC / ST / PH these candidates (Residing in W.B.) are reserved as per Govt. rules.

FOR DEPUTED TRAINEES

50% seats are reserved for the deputed trainees coming from recognized Govt. aided Higher Secondary, Secondary Schools of West Bengal. Such trainees are selected on the basis of length of service as an approved teacher in respective schools. If, service length becomes identical for more than one trainees then academic qualification will be considered.

Deputed teachers have to produce the following certificates at the time of interview.

(i) Copy of his / her service approval letter issued by the respective D.I.

ii) A copy of the Managing Committee's resolution in the supplied format or the school Administration's order for deputation and duly countersigned by the D.I. of the respective district mentioning that he/she is the first/second candidate being deputed by the school for training during the current session, is a must.

This letter also should mention candidate's length of service.

After admission (if selected) : A deputed teacher shall have to submit : his/her last pay certificate countersigned by the D.I. of the respective district for the month of June of the current year.

Release certificate from the school w.e.f. 1st July of the current academic year failing which the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

COURSES OF STUDY

(A) Compulsory Paper : A candidate has to take the following subjects as compulsory paper.

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Library fee, College Examination fees excluding University Examination Fees.
